To the Organizing Committee,

Please find enclosed information for running a cattle Dog Trial under the NSW Working Stock Dog Association rules.

Expectations

- The trial should be run to a high standard with the Code of Conduct followed at all times
- Animal welfare of all livestock and dogs is to be observed and practiced for all aspects of the trial
- Livestock should be handled on foot with dogs prior to the event
- The draw is to be done in rounds (can be blended) and a copy of the full draw printed for each competitor

Insurance

- If use of the association's insurance is required it is a one time only cost of \$200 and the organizing committee must have a minimum of 4 current members of the association

Advertisement

- For an event to be affiliated i.e. for points to be awarded to competitors, the event should be open to all interested in entering and be advertised in advance in the association newsletter and/or website. The date, location, events, rules to be used, contact details and closing date for nominations will need to be listed

Sponsorship

- A sum of up to \$300 per event is available in order to purchase Cobber dog food for the place getters. A copy of original purchase invoice can be sent to the NSW association treasurer for reimbursement of these funds. To honor sponsorship commitments Cobber product and banners should be displayed at the event. Cobber banners can be obtained from the NSW association. Also as Cobber are the major sponsors of the NSW Working Stock Dog Association no opposing product/brands should be displayed at the event

Rules

- All NSW Working Stock Dog trials should be run under one of the approved rule sets, these can be found on the website
